HOW TO PREPARE FOR A RECRUITMENT WEEKEND

Testimony

Practice a 3-5 minute testimony to share in a small group.

- When telling a testimony, you are simply telling the story of Jesus Christ making Himself known in your life. There are three elements, keep the main focus on the last two points: o What was your life like before Jesus?
 - o How did you meet Jesus (this does not have to be a lightning bolt moment)?
 - o How does the Gospel shape your life now?

Interviews

Please think about 3 - 4 professional or leadership experiences that you have had in school, work, internships, clubs, fraternities, etc. We are particularly interested in experiences in which you worked in groups over a significant period of time. At least one of these experiences will be ministry specific, such as leading retreats, Bible studies, Catholic Center board member, etc. Please note, these may be the same experiences listed in your application but may change if further reflection shows that other examples may be more pertinent.

Interviews will consist of in-depth conversations about these leadership experiences, looking for examples of behaviors embodying these qualities:

- **Faithfulness** Are you faithful to the teachings of Jesus and His Church? Do you have a fidelity to personal prayer and the pursuit of holiness?
- Zeal for Souls– Flowing from the love you have received from God and your sincere love for your neighbor, do you desire to share Christ with others? How have you shown this?
- **Team Player** How would you be as a live-in, work-with teammate? How do you respond to conflict?
- **Teachability** How do you respond to direction and authority? What kind of leadership or management style helps you to best perform?
- Leadership How would you describe your leadership style? To what degree are you a self-starter?
- **Professionalism** Do you practice excellence in the workplace through punctuality, organization, communication, etc.?

• Indomitability — How do you respond to failures, defeat and frustration?
